Timing and Online Registration (Bill Bryant, Joe O'Leary):

Currently we use RaceMenu (An Ras Mor) and BayState (24 Hour & Gobble). How should we proceed? RaceMenu wants to do timing and registration. They are also offering a new feature of race photography that will be free for the runners to download or share. Do we lock in a fees for the next few years?

Summer Steamer (Jim Sullivan, Robin):

Jim Sullivan has quit the committee. Jim Sweeney said they have no viable dates or location for post-party. We have agreed to discontinue this race for 2012, but maybe in the future bring it back if there is renewed interest. We can hold a special Thursday Night run on the Steamer course.

Long Runs (Bill Hees)

May 5/6 there will be a joint run and party with CRC (same weekend as the Tough Mudder so a dozen or so won't be able to run it). Will email club and CRC to see if someone can host. Does SRR chip in for food and beverages?

An Ras Mor (Brendan):

500 signups as of now, way ahead of last year. Need more volunteers. This is the first stop on the Pub Series.

26 x 1 (Brendan):

Sun, June 23. Tim Trovel at Tufts is our contact. Greater Framingham already sign up, Back on My Feet signed up. 12 teams last year, might cap at 15 teams. CRC and Wicked have expressed interest. CRC would like to be more involved in social part. Amanda Brewster at CRC.

24-Hour Relay (Noel):

50 entrants so far, ahead of last year. Permit went from 300 to 350. Prize money this year to attract faster runners. We are seeing about getting medical aid and trainers at the race.

Thursday Night Run (Scott):

Pre-Boston pasta-party is April 12. Will email club to get a head-count for Michael. After Boston, will set up schedule for PR race, Double Dare, other fun races.

SRR Grand Prix (Kate):

End of Grand Prix BBQ set for May 20 at Tim and Erin's house in Arlington. Kate will trim the list of runners after New Bedford/Quincy Halves to those who have run at least three races. Awards will be given out there. There will be no summer Grand Prix due to heavy club race schedule.

Boston Marathon (Kate):
